

Important Symptoms to Report while you are Pregnant

If at any time in your pregnancy you develop any of the following symptoms, call our office at 201-457-2300

1. Any Vaginal Bleeding
2. Leaking, escape of fluid from your vagina, or change in vaginal discharge
3. Swelling of your hands and fingers
4. Severe or continuous headache
5. Dimness, double vision, blurring of vision, or “spots” before your eyes
6. Abdominal pain
7. Premature contractions -contractions 4-6 times and hour prior to 37 weeks of pregnancy (pressure, tightness, cramping, or backache)
8. Labor contractions-contractions every 5 minutes or closer after 37 weeks of pregnancy
9. Decreased Fetal Movement- less than 10 baby movements in 2 hours after 28 weeks of pregnancy
10. Persistent vomiting
11. Chills or fever- temperature 100 or higher
12. Pain or burning during urination
